BIRDLIFE AT KWANDWE PRIVATE GAME RESERVE

Set within 74,000 acres (30,000 hectares) of pristine wilderness, Kwandwe Private Game Reserve is a birdwatcher's paradise, hosting an extraordinary diversity of avian species. With over 300 bird species recorded, the reserve is home to iconic birds like the majestic African Fish Eagle and the elusive African Black Oystercatcher. Visitors can also spot a variety of colorful and unique species, including Malachite Kingfishers, Secretarybirds, and the endangered Blue Crane. The reserve's diverse habitats, from riverine thickets to open savannah, provide sanctuary to these incredible birds, making it a must-visit destination for birding enthusiasts.
